# CAMP CHANCO

The purpose of Camp Chanco is to provide an opportunity for boys and girls to experience Christian Camping in a wilderness setting. In a relaxed and fun atmosphere we seek to develop a community in which young people will become more self-aware, more sharing among themselves, and more deeply related to our Lord. This is fostered within the warmth of Christian community and nurtured by the development of individual camper skills in canoeing, swimming, sailing, biking, campcraft, and nature lore. In no other context can young people experience the vitality of discovery, exploration, learning, sharing, and sheer fun!

**CANOE TRIPS** explore various rivers and inlets of eastern Virginia. This adventure will permit canoeists to experience a full spectrum of canoeing environments and share in group camping, tenting and outdoor cooking.

**MARINERS CAMP:** a six-day in-camp experience introducing campers to the pleasures of sailing. Designed for beginners, the course will cover basic sailing skills and knowledge. Campers will spend several hours each day on the water and, if skills permit, may take an overnight trip.

**THE GRAND ADVENTURE** is an outtripper's dream! Campers will experience biking, hiking, rappelling, canoeing, and then tubing on the James River as the grande finale.

**NOTE: Grand Adventure applicants MUST previously have participated in at least one (1) outtrip experience with Camp Chanco.**

**JUNIOR HIGH CONFERENCE** is a program coupling the best of our traditional camping experiences with a theme-centered event that will challenge campers with the physical demands and fun of camp life, while providing a greater opportunity for emotional and spiritual growth with the guidance of experienced youth leaders.

**SENIOR HIGH CONFERENCE** is a camping/conference program designed to enable older teenagers to experience the building of community and to discover, with GOD's help, what it means to be the persons they were created to be. Conference workshops led by accomplished Christian educators are combined with usual camping activities to offer an exciting learning experience.
