To All Participants in the Senior High Conference, 1980:

Note to scholarship applicants: If you applied to Camp Chanco, your church or another organization for a scholarship, enter the amount of your request on the RETURN FORM and subtract it from the fee balance. (Notification of Camp Chanco scholarships will be mailed by June 1.)

STORE CARDS: Campers attending on-site sessions are asked not to bring money to camp. (Sr. High conferees and trip campers are exceptions to this rule.) Indicate on the RETURN FORM the amount you are depositing in the camper's store account. (The recommended limit is \$10-\$15.) A record of purchases will be kept on file at the camp store (this is a "store card") and unspent money will be refunded at the close of the session. See the General Information sheet for a list of items sold.

SCHOLARSHIP FUND: Many young people are dependent upon financial assistance in order to attend camp. Won't you please include a donation with your camper's payment to help another child? No gift is too small to help us assist these campers.

Contract for
COMMUNITY LIFE STANDARDS FOR SENIOR HIGH CONFERENCE
CAMP CHANCO

We, the persons gathering together for the Senior High Conference at Camp Chanco, DO HEREBY CONTRACT with each other and the Conference Staff, TO ABIDE BY the following requirements of orderly COMMUNITY LIFE, and WE take upon ourselves the responsibility for living in accordance with them and in helping others to do so:

1. There will be no co-ed visiting between camp sites.
2. There will be a fixed curfew. (The time for curfew will be determined at the first session of the conference.)
3. The use or possession of alcoholic beverages and the illegal use of drugs are strictly prohibited. (Prescription drugs and/or other medicines must be turned over to the camp nurse during registration.)
4. Safety measures pertaining to water activities:
Waterfront regulations based on the standards of the National Red Cross Water Safety Program will be carried out by Camp Chanco's waterfront director.
5. Full time participation is essential for the welfare of the total community. This means attendance at all meals and scheduled activities. Each member of the community is expected to be on time for scheduled activities. A conferee can be excused from activities only at the discretion of the nurse and/or the director.
6. The bounds of the camp are the camp property plus the area of the Marina Store. While the conference is in session, all members are required to be within these specified bounds. (Boundaries will be defined in detail at the opening session of the conference.)
7. Conferees driving cars to camp are not permitted to use them during the conference. A parking area will be designated by the director.
8. No visitors are allowed during the conference.

Additional standards will be discussed as our community is formed and throughout the life of the conference.
